This week, we are beginning to work in Unit 5 of our reading curriculum. We will be focusing on Comparing and Contrasting information. Students received a new reading log this week. This week we will continue our unit on fractions. We will be looking at equivalent fractions and order fractions from least to greatest or greatest to least. A great way to begin talking to your student about fractions is while driving on the highway. Talk to them about what it means when an exit is $\frac{1}{4}$ or $\frac{1}{2}$ a mile a way, for example. While you are cooking is another great

conversation! Have them put the measuring cups in order from least to greatest without looking at them. Ask them to figure out how many $\frac{1}{4}$ cups are in a $\frac{1}{2}$ cup, for example.

Monday Math this week looks a little bit differently. There is still the usual Monday Math but there is a page attached. On the page there is practice for Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday. On Monday evening, for example, they should complete the Monday column. On Tuesday in class, we will go over Monday's column to make sure they are on the right path. On Tuesday evening they should complete the Tuesday column so we can go over it together in class on Wednesday etc.
