This week we will continue our unit on fractions. We will be looking at equivalent fractions and order fractions from least to greatest or greatest to least. Next we will take a look at adding fractions that have the same denominator. A great way to begin talking to your student about fractions is while driving on the highway. Talk to them about what it means when an exit is $1 / 4$ or $1 / 2$ a mile a way, for example. While you are cooking is another great conversation! Have them put the measuring cups in order from least to greatest without looking at them. Ask them to figure out how many $1 / 4$ cups are in a $1 / 2$ cup, for example.
